## Winston-Salem's MORAMUS CHORALE

The Moramus Chorale was organized in 1976 with the specific purpose of presenting music from the collections of the Moravian Music Foundation. The Chorale has performed numerous concerts over the years including a program of contemporary Moravian Music at the 13th Moravian Music Festival in 1978, and a recreation of a 1789 lovefeast ode at the 1996 Moravian Music Festival. In 2009, the Chorale was the Monday evening featured presentation of the 23rd Moravian Music Festival in Belmont, NC. Most recently the chorale performed Johann Friedrich Peter's *Psalm of Joy* as part of Old Salem, Inc.'s Independence Day Celebration at Home Moravian Church.

### JOIN THE CHORALE

The Chorale is an SATB mixed chorus open to anyone with choral experience and who loves to sing. Rehearsals occur on the fourth Tuesday of the month with some additional rehearsals around performance dates. If you appreciate singing, enjoy fellowship with others, enjoy and appreciate Moravian and Early American music, then the Moramus Chorale is for you!
